Course Duration: 150 hours

Course Description:

This course provides knowledge of learning the Korean language, more than basic and less than advanced level in learning grammatical patterns, and equipping oneself with the level of socialisation through communication and its cultural facts.

Course Objectives:

1. The course focuses on developing intermediate-level written and communicative skills of learners.
2. It enables students to gain fluency in reading.
3. It improves the learner's imagination while writing sentences and essays at an intermediate level.

Course Outcome

1. Students can gain familiarity with the intermediate level sentence structures and grammatical patterns.
2. It broadens the linguistic knowledge by enhancing the student's ability to communicate with Korean natives.

Course outline:

- Intermediate level grammar patterns pertaining to supposition, purpose, state and continuance, reason, causatives, determiner and contrasting, etc.
- Intermediate-level dialogues pertaining to various aspects of daily life

- Essays regarding Korean script, Indo-Korea relations, Korean Military System, Korean and Indian Festivals, National Flag of India and Korea, and other thought-provoking essays on various topics

Student Evaluation

This course is a one-year program in a mode. It contains three papers, of which 2 are theory and one is a practical paper.

1. Script and Translation
2. Grammar, Comprehension and Essay
3. Audio-Oral Examination

The evaluation will be done in two phases. One is through internal examination, and the other is the final examination. Internal examination schedules for January/February and the final examination for April/May every year.
